The Chatham Skating Club is a non-profit organization that operates under Skate Canada and Skate Ontario.

What an interesting year it has been to step into the role of President. From new restrictions and vaccine passports, to complete shut downs, and then to the lifting of restrictions, it has been quite a journey. I want to start off by thanking every one of you for your support of the club through this time.

The 2021-2022 season did have a number of successful moments for our club. After a two-year hiatus, we were able to offer CanSkate and Pre-CanSkate sessions again. In the Fall and Winter, we held an Adult program that was very well received. We also offered two new programs: a CanPowerSkate session and a Group STARSkate session. It is our intent to offer all of these programs in the 2022-2023 season.

Our skaters achieved much success as well. There were a number of tests passed and competitions attended. We had a pop concert in April for our STARSkaters to showcase their programs. We were able to celebrate their success at our 2021-2022 Awards Celebration at Kingston Park in June. I want to thank Morand and Burke Family Dentistry for their sponsorship of the ceremony. I would also like to congratulate all of our skaters.

I was able to start working on a number of small projects for the club this year. Most of them involved creating policy documents that are required by our governing bodies and updating our historical records. If anyone has club information from pre-1990, I would be happy to receive it. I was also able to update our corporation information with the Ontario government. New legislation (ONCA) requires that this is completed each year. I have started the slow process of cleaning up and organizing the storage area at the arena.

A huge thank you goes to our dedicated volunteers and coaches. During the year, everyone worked very hard to keep our skaters on the ice as much as possible. The Chatham Skating Club will continue to succeed only with your help.

I look forward to helping the club grow over the next year.

Report for Chatham Skating Club 2022 AGM from Booster Club of Chatham-Kent Skaters

The Booster Club of Chatham Kent Skaters is a group of dedicated parents that fundraise to offset their child's skating costs and provide financial support to the Chatham Skating Club.

Bursaries are awarded quarterly to the skaters when eligible receipts totaling the dollar amount of the monies raised are submitted to the Booster Club. Eligible receipts include those for registration fees, ice fees, coaching fees, competition fees and expenses, music fees, skates and equipment, and skating clothes. The receipts must be in the name of the skater and must be dated within the twelve months prior to the bursary payout period.

During 2021 the Covid 19 Pandemic continued to greatly affect the ability for Booster Club to carry out it's usual activities like working bingos and doing fundraisers such as selling Get Out and Save CK coupon books.

Normally members of the Booster Club work a minimum of eight bingos per quarter at Riverview Gaming Center in Chatham. The monies raised from bingos are split between the Chatham Skating Club (25%) and the Booster Club (75%). The Booster Club portion of the proceeds are awarded as bursaries to the skaters.

The monies raised from fundraisers are awarded 100% as bursaries to the skaters.

For 2021 the Booster Club motioned to donate \$2,600 to the Chatham Skating Club, in addition to providing the normal 25% of bingo funding received from Riverview Gaming Center. There was no funding received during January, April and June of 2021. The only month where members worked bingos in the hall was November 2021, and the remaining months Booster club was required to do online posts for participation points to earn a share in Riverview Gaming Center revenues. The bingo hall was open for the gaming machines for some months of 2021 and did online (at home) bingos with their customers thereby generating revenues.

For the period January 1, 2021 to March 31, 2022 (15 months), the Booster Club received \$5,101.83 from Riverview Gaming Center of which \$3,875.45 remained with the Chatham Skating Club to use at their discretion. \$330.87 was paid out to local skaters over this period while \$895.51 was kept for covering future expenses of the Booster club.

The Booster Club welcomes any new members and would ask the board to encourage the parents of any level of skater to contact Karen Andari for more information. All activities are optional with the understanding that if you choose not to participate in a specific event or sale, you will not share the proceeds from that event.

Participation in Booster is an awesome way to help families financially with skating costs of their child and at the same time help the Chatham Skating Club without a huge commitment of time.

Chatham Skating Club Coaches Report 2021-2022

It was great to be able to welcome the CanSkaters back to the rink. This meant that we had to hire more coaches to ensure the program ran smoothy. Fall started out slow, but by the time we started Winter all the CanSkate sessions were filling up.

We ran a StarSkate group program, this past year, to help bridge the CanSkate and the StarSkate programs. I felt this was very successful to helped keep skaters in the club.

The CanPowerSkate program was introduced this year as well. Skaters can now continue to improve their skating skills with the club after CanSkate.

Coaches had two meetings this past year. It was nice to see so many coaches attend and be able to add input into the future of the club.

I would like to thank all the coaches, board and volunteers for making this, such a successful year. When we all work together, it makes for a harmonious club.

Test Day Summary Report April 1, 2021 – May 31, 2022

Star 1 to 5 tests continue to be tested by coaches and Star 6 to Diamond tests are judged by a Skate Canada qualified judge. There was not an official "test day" this season as tests were done on regular STARSkate ice during which a judge was brought in.

A total of 58 Star 1 to 5 tests were tried at our club by our coaches this year. All of them passed.

A total of 17 Star 6 – Diamond tests were tried at our club by a judge, 13 passed and 4 retried.

No out-of-town tests were tried.

Total Test Revenue: \$1,036.00 Paid to Judges: \$50.00 Submitted to Skate Canada for fees: \$900.00 Profit for the Year: \$86.00
